#### **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of this document is to provide a description of the proposed file based reporting language for the Market Data division of the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (NYSE).

#### **OVERVIEW**

Traditionally, vendors fulfilled their reporting obligations by uploading their "VARS" files to <a href="http://www.tcbdata.com">http://www.tcbdata.com</a>. The group at TCBData would receive these files, provide a level of processing and extraction, and then dispersed the files to the appropriate markets including NYSE Market Data. The Market Data staff members then reviewed the files for completeness.

The NYSE announced last year that it intends to add choice and efficiency to the current reporting practices. The NYSE's plans included the following:

- 1. Establishing a NYSE facility to accept vendor reports directly as well as from VARS files. (Completed 12/2001)
- 2. Transitioning from current "transaction change" reporting to total inventory reporting. (Effort underway, to be completed in 2003)
- 3. Developing value-added administrative services for vendors and their customer. (Ongoing effort)
- 4. Developing more efficient, industry-accepted data transfer methodologies to enable straight-through-processing.

We would hope that this proposed Vendor Reporting eXtensible Markup Language (VRXML) schema will be available for use by the end of the year 2002. Working with the FISD, we wish to gather comments and feedback prior to our implementation.

#### VRXML STRUCTURE

The XML structure is a new format that the Market Data division of the NYSE has developed. The working name of this new structure is Vendor Reporting eXtensible Markup Language (VRXML). The XML structure is based upon the original VARS format but adds additional functionality and efficiency. The capability to transform an existing VARS file into a VRXML file is a requirement.

#### **Primary Elements:**

File Descriptor: Provides information about the file itself

Vendor Change Entry: Represents company, contact, and location information for a vendor

Inventory Entry: Represents one location's set of inventory elements for a company

(subscriber or vendor)

Subscriber New Entry: Represents information about a new subscriber for the reporting

vendor

Subscriber Change Entry: Represents changes to subscriber information including company changes, location changes, and new locations for that subscriber

#### **Rules:**

- Each file will have one File Descriptor
- Each file will have at least one other primary element (endor Change, Inventory, Subscriber New, or Subscriber Change)
- Each file will abide by the VRXML Schema
